Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize permit are:

- * 120' long X 12'5" wide X 13'10" high, 80,000 lbs. - Unlimited distance - routing required
- * 120' long X 14'6" wide X 15'5" high, 80,000 lbs. - Movement restricted to 50 miles radius unless the route continues on at least 4-lane roads or trip routes are obtained from Humboldt County.
- * 120' long X 16' wide X 15'5" high, 80,000 lbs. - Trip route must be obtained
- * 75' X 12'5" wide X 13'6" high, 80,000 lbs. - Maximum dimensions for hauling hay.

CARRIER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING NECESSARY ROUTE APPROVAL PRIOR TO MOVE
